Gospel Reflection

The Darkness and the Light

Jesus and his three best friends climbed the mountain to pray, but Jesus did all the praying. The others napped, exhausted by the climb or bored by the task of praying. And because they slept, they very nearly missed the radiance of the Transfiguration. When they awoke, the glory still lingered around Jesus, not to mention his two unmistakable guests.

But they hardly saw the radiance before being overshadowed by a cloud. Where would you expect God to be found: in the brilliance or the shadow? Actually, God is revealed in both. God's glory is seen in the light, but God's voice is heard in the darkness. How often has this been true in our experience as well? We celebrate God's nearness and blessing in the happy times, at the birth of a child or the marvel of a new snowball. But we can hear God's voice ring out on a bleak city backstreet, and in the season of illness. When we insist on seeing God only in the good times, we find ourselves apparently abandoned when we need God's

comforting presence the most. God is with us, in the light and in the darkness.


