Gospel Reflection

Coming Home

Think of a time when you've been unexpectedly, generously, undeservedly forgiven. I remember a dreadful day at university when I hurt my closest friend. Nadine was from a Pentecostal Christian tradition, and I, in a ham-fisted attempted to "defend the faith," told her all about the theological errors as there were abundantly clear to me after twelve years or narrow-minded schooling. (Lucky for me, no one was in the room at the time to point out mine!)

This "correction" caused my friend a great deal of pain, since I patently rejected her sincere walk with Jesus. I retired to my room feeling curiously awful about being very "right" about God. Thank God one of us understood something about the nature of Christianity. Later that evening, Nadine sought me out and put her arm around me. We both cried together about the spirit of self-righteousness that had made me willing to forsake our friendship. You don't make that mistake twice in a lifetime. When you understand the love that's yours in the arms of God, you don't leave home again.

When have you felt like the prodigal son, undeserving of his father's love? When have you been the self-righteous brother, unwilling to welcome the wayfarer home?

Lent is the season to get right with God and others. Only you know the places where your heart is broken. Sometimes we need to reconcile with people who have died. It's never too late to forgive.
