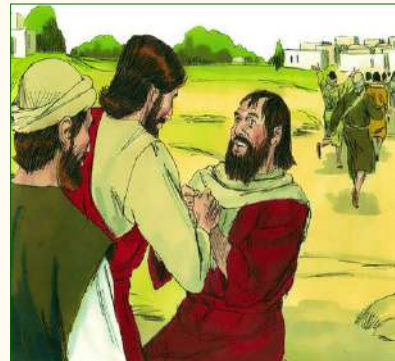

An Attitude of Gratitude

(Luke 17: 11 - 19)

This week, Jesus asks a piercing question after healing ten lepers: "Were not ten healed? Where are the nine?" Only one healed leper comes back to give thanks – and it is that act of gratitude that draws him into deeper relationship with Jesus.

This moment is more than a story about healing; it is a reminder about awareness. So many good things happen in our lives every day – answered prayers, simple joys, unexpected kindnesses. But like the nine who hurried on, we often move past them without stopping to say thank you.

As parishioners and families, we are invited to be the ones who return. Gratitude changes how we see our lives. It opens our eyes to God's presence in the ordinary: in the laughter at the dinner table, the strength to get through a tough day, the love shared in a parish community. Gratitude shifts our focus from what we lack to what we've been given.

This week, try to pause and name what you're thankful for. Say a prayer of thanks before meals, on the way to work, or while putting the kids to bed. Let "thank you, Lord" become a rhythm in your home and heart.

When we return to give thanks, we find that gratitude doesn't just bless God – it transforms us. Like the healed man, we rise renewed, ready to live our faith with joy.

"Gratitude is the memory of the heart." (Saint Mary of the Cross MacKillop)
