**Keep Coming Back: The Power of Persistent Prayer** (Luke 18: 1 - 8)

Jesus tells the story of a persistent widow who keeps coming to a judge, asking for justice. She refuses to give up, and eventually, the judge grants her request – not because he cares about her, but because of her perseverance. Jesus uses this story to teach us a vital lesson: we should always pray and never give up.

The widow's determination challenges us to look at our own approach to faith and prayer. How often do we give up too soon when life feels overwhelming? How quickly do we lose hope when solutions or answers do not come on our timetable? The widow reminds us that persistence is not stubbornness – it is a trust that God is present, listening, and working even when we cannot see the outcome.

For families, the story highlights the importance of supporting one another in daily struggles. Life brings challenges that test patience, resilience, and hope. Prayer and persistence provide a shared anchor. When children see parents returning to God in prayer, or when siblings encourage each other through difficulty, faith becomes lived and visible.

In parish communities, the widow's persistence calls us to pray not only for our own needs but for the needs of others. Community prayer, ongoing support, and collective perseverance become powerful testimonies of faith. When we refuse to give up on God or on one another, we strengthen the bonds that make our parishes and neighbourhoods alive with hope and love. (See Page 2 for Response in Action)




