SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME Year C - 27 July 2025



"Ask and it will be given to you" (Luke 11: 1 - 13)

Prayer can feel like a mystery. Sometimes we don't know what to say ... But this week, Jesus cuts through all that confusion. His disciples – ordinary people like us – ask him, "Lord, teach us to pray." And in response, he doesn't give them a theology lecture. He gives them the Our Father – a prayer so simple a child can memorise it, yet so deep it can reshape your soul.

Jesus invites us to pray as children of a loving Father – not as beggars hoping for crumbs, but as daughters and sons claiming our inheritance. He shows us that God is not distant or disinterested. God listens. God cares. God gives. God provides. Even when we don't understand the delays or the silence, Jesus tells us to keep knocking – not because God needs convincing, but because we need transforming.

But here's the challenge: Do we pray with expectation, or with low hopes? Do we seek God's will with open hands, or are we just trying to get God to rubber-stamp our plans? Jesus promises: "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you." That's not a blank cheque. It's an invitation to enter a relationship with God – one marked by trust, persistence, and humility.

This Gospel confronts us with a radical truth: God wants to give us the Holy Spirit. Not just good things. Not just help with rent or healing or daily needs. God desires to pour God's life into us, if we'll just be open. That's the core of it. That's the real gift.

So, here's the invitation today: **Pray boldly.** Not with entitlement, but with confidence that God sees you and loves you. **Pray persistently.** Sometimes God's greatest work happens in the waiting. **Pray expectantly.** God may not always give you what you want, but God will always give you what you need to become who you're called to be. **Pray relationally.** The goal of prayer is not just answers. It's intimacy with God.

Finally: become the answer to someone else's prayer. Maybe God is asking you to be the one who shows up, speaks truth, lends a hand, makes peace, or brings hope. Prayer leads to action. Real disciples don't just pray "Your Kingdom come" – they live like the Kingdom is breaking in right now, through them.

So today, don't just recite the "Our Father." Let it shape your heart, guide your steps, and change your world.
